In retrospect, I look upon those ideals as lifelong gifts that my parents bestowed upon me.

"God bless America" wasn't just a phrase that my parents and grandparents often recited. It was an expression of their deeply-rooted belief in our Country and of their love of the United States ... a belief and love that I share.

Perhaps as never before, our country requires bold, innovative, and decisive leadership ... leadership that is devoid of ego, insulated from undue influence, and predicated upon enforcing the values upon which this great Nation was formed. It is a gap that must be filled ... and one that I take it very seriously.




